WOMEN'S BOXING TO BE INCLUDED AT LONDON 2012

The International Olympic Committee (IOC) has approved to include women's amateur boxing at the London 2012 Olympic Games. Because the popularity of the sport has grown considerably in recent years, the IOC has decided that there is going to be a competition in the capital in three years' time.



Rebecca Gibson, the National Women's Boxing Development Manager at the Amateur Boxing Association of England, commented: "The decision reflects the **increasing** popularity of women's boxing at every level. The number of

boxers with gold medals at the recent EU Championships is larger **and this** can only improve Great Britain's medal prospects at the 2012 Games". Women are going to fight in three weight classes as part of the 2012 Olympic programme. The International Female Boxers Association began in February 1997. **It** is going to host the second world title fights in Seoul, South Korea, in October.

Boxing is a British sport. The Marquess of Queensberry established the rules in 1865. **In the UK, boxing is both amateur and professional**, and the Boxing Association of England applies **strict** medical regulations in both.
